### Prevention and conduct

Recommended safety measures for handling the undiluted product:

<b>Appropriate engineering controls:</b>	Provide a good standard of general ventilation.
<b>Appropriate organisational controls:</b>	Avoid direct contact and/or splashes where possible. Train personnel.
<b>Personal protective equipment</b>	
<b>Eye / face protection:</b>	Safety glasses are not normally required. However, their use is recommended in those cases where splashes may occur when handling the product (EN 166).
<b>Hand protection:</b>	Rinse and dry hands after use. For prolonged contact protection for the skin may be necessary.
<b>Body protection:</b>	No special requirements under normal use conditions.
<b>Respiratory protection:</b>	No special requirements under normal use conditions.
<b>Environmental exposure controls:</b>	No special requirements under normal use conditions.

### Emergency procedure



<b>Suitable extinguishing media</b>	Carbon dioxide. Dry powder. Water spray jet. Fight larger fires with water spray jet or alcohol-resistant foam.
<b>Environmental precautions</b>	Do not allow to enter drainage system, surface or ground water. Dilute with plenty of water.
<b>Methods for cleaning up</b>	Absorb with liquid-binding material (sand, diatomite, universal binders, sawdust).

### First aid measures



<b>Inhalation:</b>	Get medical attention or advice if you feel unwell.
<b>Skin contact:</b>	Wash skin with plenty of lukewarm, gently flowing water. If skin irritation occurs: Get medical advice or attention.
<b>Eye contact:</b>	Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. If irritation occurs and persists, get medical attention.
<b>Ingestion:</b>	Rinse mouth. Immediately drink 1 glass of water. Get medical attention or advice if you feel unwell.
